1 This folio keyboard case for iPad 2 or later is a mixed bag. It's comfortable to type on, but the way the character keys extend all the way to the left of the keyboard takes some getting used to. The caps lock and tab functions are found on the **[A]** and **[Q]** keys respectively, and activated by holding a modifier key.

Magnets hold the iPad in position when typing, and also hold it closed when packed away for transport. At over 2cm thick, it adds a lot of bulk to your slimline Apple tablet, which is something not everyone will find acceptable. **Ian Osborne**

2 Choosing an iPad mini case is very much a personal thing. What's stylish and attractive to some might look garish or boring to others. However, few could be disappointed with this one from Maroo. Its purple leather cover with black trim and slate grey interior looks great, and it's functional too, holding your iPad mini safely and securely. Elastic corners keep it shut, there's a flap for notes, a hole for the camera and a holder for a pen. You can also fold back the cover to use it as a stand, though the position is a little wobbly. **Ian Osborne**

3 This 10-button laser mouse is designed for day-to-day use as well as gaming. Its sensor is a relatively low-res 990 dpi, which might not suit hardcore gamers, but it can track on almost any surface – even glass. As well as programming via a simple drag-and-drop interface, you can also download ready-made custom profiles for a range of games and also applications such as Adobe Creative Suite and Microsoft Office. It's not as customisable as Mad Catz' R.A.T. series and doesn't come with replacement body parts, but its palm rest is adjustable. **Ian Osborne**

4 There are numerous wireless 'n'-compatible extenders that improve the range of your 2.4GHz or 5GHz wireless network, but the Edimax 300+ (note the 'plus') goes a step further and extends both wavebands simultaneously. It also has an Ethernet port so you can make a cabled connection, using the extender as a Wi-Fi bridge. It works with any wireless router, and is great for reaching dead spots in your household network. It's easy to set up too, though more advanced features are there for those that need them. **Ian Osborne**
